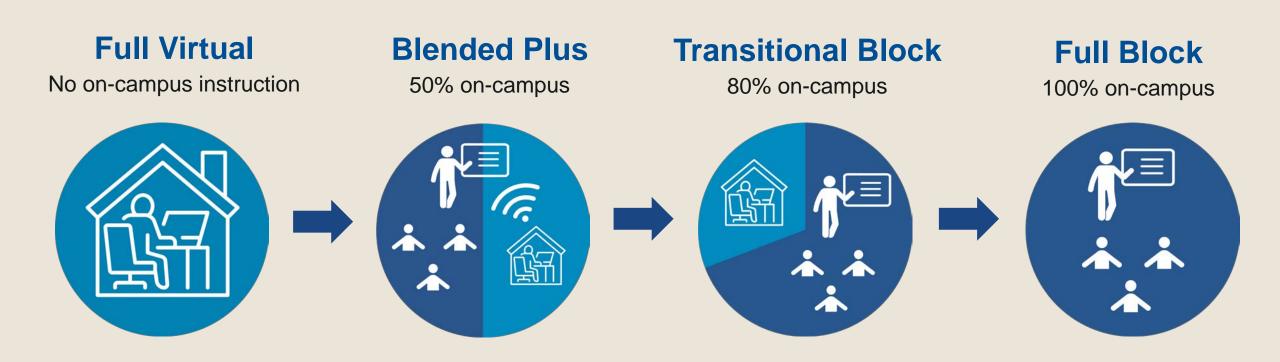
The SMCHS reopening plan was developed in **full collaboration** with the Diocese of Orange Catholic Schools





Instructional models for flexibility

Four progressive phases:



Full Virtual

Starts August 17

What is expected:

- Attendance will be taken each period and monitored by Attendance Office
- Live instruction / real-time feedback / collaboration
- Classwork during scheduled period
- A monitored workload similar to on-campus instruction, meaningful homework and reliable assessments
- Camera on during direct instruction and/or group discussion
- Counselors available to meet virtually
- College counseling workshops
- Comprehensive professional development to prepare for the school year

Blended Plus

50% on-campus instruction

- Students split into morning and afternoon sessions (M & T, Th & Fri)
- Wednesdays: asynchronous day
 - Faculty office hours, in-person testing center
 - Further sanitize and disinfect
 - Opportunities for campus ministry / extracurricular activities
- Full virtual instruction available upon request

Transitional Block

80% on-campus instruction

- Monday, "all periods day":
 - Periods 1-7: Virtual instruction
- Tuesday Friday:
 - All students on campus for "block" schedule instruction
 - Academic period
- Full virtual instruction available upon request



Full Block

100% on-campus instruction

- Monday Friday:
 - All students on campus
- Monday is "all periods" day
 - Periods 1-7, on-campus instruction for all students
- Tuesday Friday:
 - All students on campus for "block" schedule instruction
- Full virtual instruction available upon request

Daily health precautions:

- Face coverings, handwashing, hand sanitizing stations, temperature checks and wellness screenings.
- Protocols from the OC Health Agency and California
 Department of Public Health will be followed if a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19.
- Training on safety / protective measures.
- 2 fulltime RN, BSN nurses

Limit and eliminate UNNECESSARY or RISKY activities

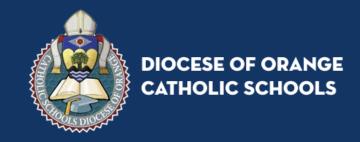
Student activities and athletics:

- Events will be modified in compliance with public health and Diocesan guidelines
- The Activities and Campus Ministry offices will provide programming in line with public health guidelines.

Practice physical distancing including:

- Increased space between desks / reconfigured spaces to promote distancing.
- Physical distancing
- Longer passing periods and the use of various schedules to minimize movement.
- Nonessential visitors on campus will be limited.

Comprehensive cleaning and disinfecting protocols including:

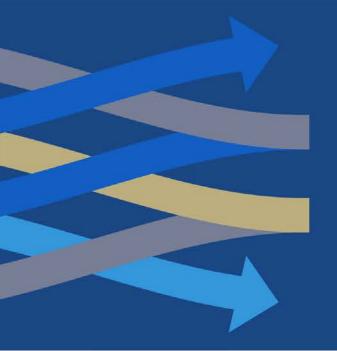
- SM Facilities dept. sanitizes and disinfects campus daily
